Hello Everyone,

I hope this finds everyone and their families doing well.

I like to remind everyone that they should hang their targets inside the posts that hold the black backards. Hanging targets on the edges of the black backers shoots off the polls holding the backers up. Then we have people shooting the wrong firearms on the wrong bays.

So, as a reminder...

- 1) The rifle bay is for all rifle, shotgun and pistol calibers
- 2) The middle bay is for pistol calibers and rimfire(s) (**NO**, your AR pistol is **NOT** a pistol caliber, it **MUST** for shot on the rifle range)
- 3) The house bay is for pistol calibers and rimfire(s)

The club is looking into new Range Rule signs to be posted at the entrances of each range. So, be on the look out for the new signs.

Please remember the pick up your trash and used targets. Place the materials into the burning barrels.
